Likewise, the USP Microbial Limits Chapter <61> provides methodology for selected indicator organisms, but not all objectionable organisms. For example, it is widely recognized that Pseudomonas cepacia is objectionable if found in a topical product or nasal solution in high numbers; yet, there are no test methods provided in the USP that will enable the identification of the presence of this microorganism.

In liquid samples, the lowest limit of detection for absence of growth is <1. As a dilution of solid foodstuffs is made in order to test the sample, the lowest limit of detection for absence of growth is <10. The product under test is considered non-inhibitory to microorganism under the defined test condition if the following condition is met. The test is valid, i.e. negative control shows no growth. The recovery of the organism from positive product control is not less than 75% when compared with the recovery of organisms from positive control.
